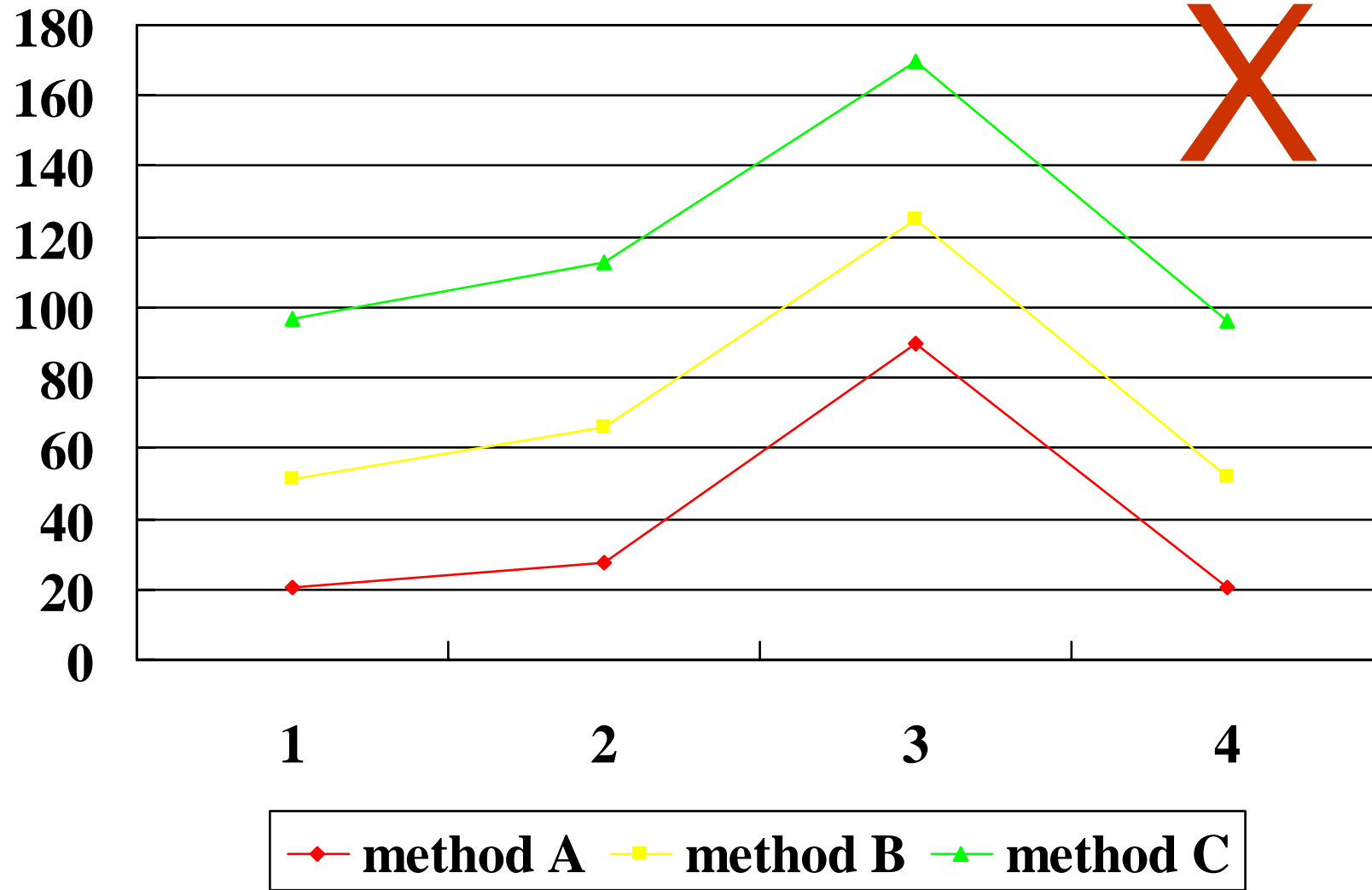
# Comparing Steve Jobs & Bill Gates

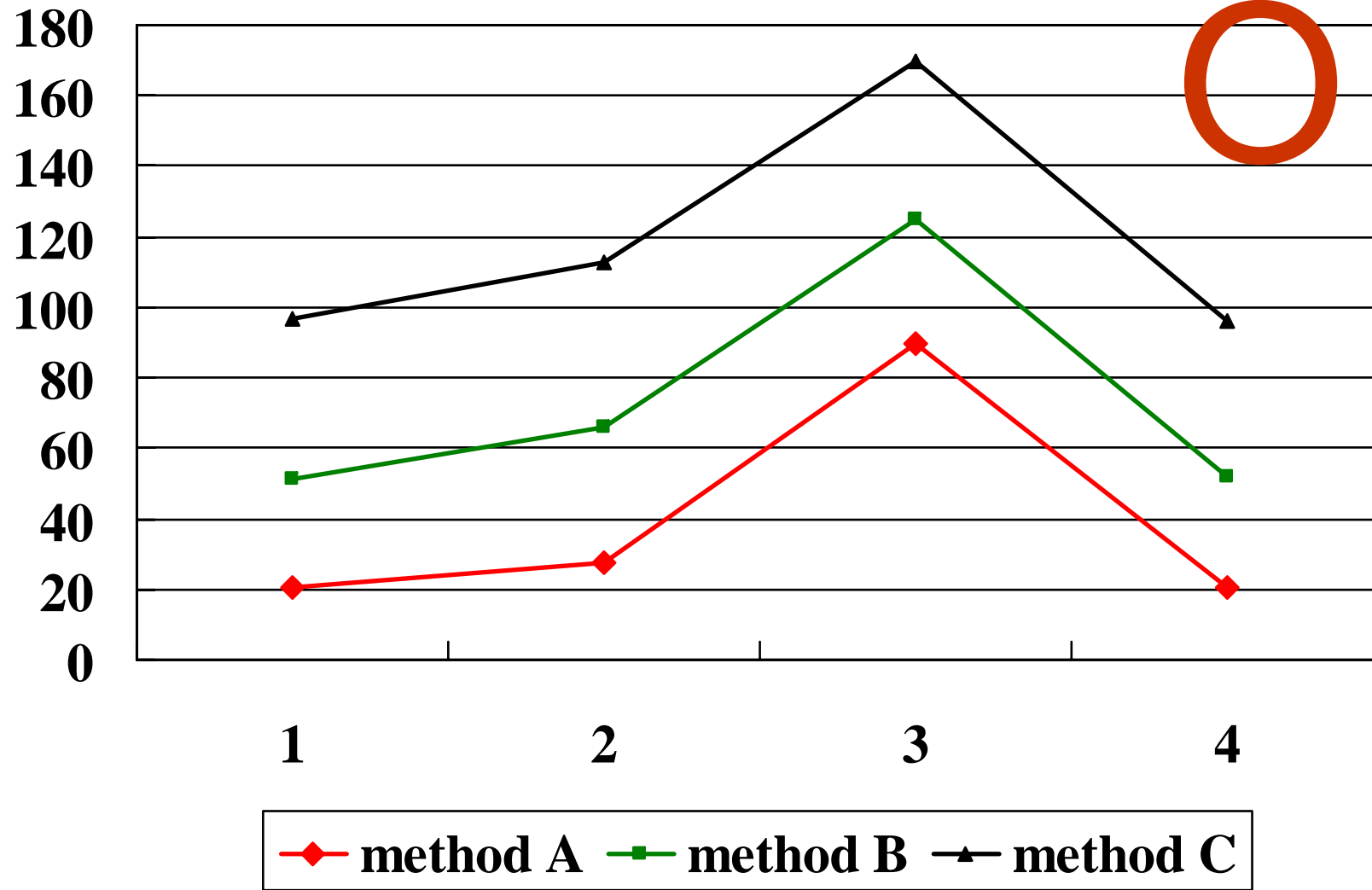
1. Simplicity

# Design a good Presentation

- Font size : 20-24
- Avoid writing too many sentences.
- Avoid unnecessary complexities (animation, picture, design, etc)
- Be careful with the color combination for font and background
- It is recommended to prepare the PDF version of your file
- Don't use yellow as font color or graph





# Tips for Research Presentation (1)

1. Don't use unconventional way to deliver your presentation. The audiences are experts and they do not want to waste their time.
2. The audiences should get the whole idea
3. In the last slides, it is recommended to repeat the important points of your presentation
4. Demonstration will make your presentation interesting
5. Time control
6. Practice with colleagues is important
7. Check the projector if it works properly

## Tips for Research Presentation (2)

8. Picture is preferred than words

9. Avoid showing too much detail (equation, etc)  
“Show the forest ! You needn’t explain each tree in the forest”
10. Keep your presentation simple but sweet (K.I.S.S)
11. Your presentation should be long enough to cover the important parts, but you have to keep it short to be attractive
12. Slide pages estimation:           1 minute: 1-1.5 pages

# Content of Thesis Presentation

1. Title
2. Background & problem
  - Why did you choose the topic ?
  - What is the problem that you want to solve ?
  - Why did you consider it to be significant ?
3. Research Purpose
4. Methods
  - Description of the method
  - Characteristics (advantages and disadvantages)
5. Experiments & Discussion
  - Good results
  - Bad results and why it happened
6. Conclusion & Future works
